Lifetime member regulations

June 19, 2016

(Eligibility)

- **Article 1** Any member of our society who meets any of the following three requirements is eligible for lifetime membership.
 - (1) A member who has paid his or her dues in full for ten years from the year he or she reached the age of 56.
 - (2) A member who has shown that he or she has paid any unpaid dues that were incurred during the ten years from the year he or she reached the age of 56.
 - (3) A member who has been approved as an advisor by the board of directors.

(Application)

Article 2 In order to become a lifetime member, an applicant must submit the designated application form and pay the lifetime membership fee of 30,000 yen. The applicant is exempt from the annual membership fee for the year in which the application is submitted.

(Rights and duties)

Article 3 A lifetime member is subject to the rights and duties stipulated in sections 2, 3, 5 and 6 of Article 8 of the ELSJ Constitution. The detailed rules regarding section 1 of Article 8 are separately specified.

(Other)

Article 4 In the case wherein a sustaining member becomes a lifetime member during his or her term of office, he or she will continue to fulfill his or her duties as a sustaining member for the remainder of that period.

Notes.

- 1. The Lifetime member regulations will come into effect, starting on April 1, 2017.
- 2. The interim measures in connection with the execution of these regulations are separately specified.
