Abstracts should be anonymous and no longer than two pages in the PDF format, including examples and references, with margins of at least 1 inch in 12-point type. On the second line of the abstract, provide the type of presentation (oral or poster) and area of research (syntax, semantics, pragmatics, etc.). We actively encourage students to submit their abstracts to the poster session. If they get a chance to make a poster presentation, the registration fee will be waivered.
